Peter Wolfhard - Brick mason, came to Berlin Canada May 1st 1854 - A sailing ship which took six weeks to cross. Aboard ship he met Marquitta Besserer from Senschein Baden, Germany, she brought with her a beautiful spinning wheel, hand carved and hand hammered german silver. It is now in the family of Harry Wolfhard Montreal. This was part of her dowry. They were married May 24th 1854. Peter Wolfhard died at the age of 81 and Mrs Wolfhard at 91. Their youngest son Henry Wolfhard a Hardware merchant in Berlin, Ont. married Elizabeth Kutt a farmer's daughter from Bamberg Ont. She died of diabetes at the age of 63 and was an ardent student of Christian Science. Their son Harry Wm. married Frances Duretha Wolfhard, Nov 20 1919 - He was a successful Executive and Vice President of Dom. Rubber Co. and their oldest daughter Leslie Maie married Wm. Fennel Fraser

Wm. Kutt came to Canada from Germany and settled in Bamberg Ont., as a farmer. He married Kate Hipes, the widow of a young minister and she died at the age of 34 having had six children. He became a widower three times. The daughter of his first wife, Elizabeth married Henry Woffhard in Berlin. Ont. a Hardware merchant who died at the age of 84. Having one son Harry Wm. and one daughter Edith Marie.

Lady Elizabeth Littlejohn from Devonshire England. and Geo Brooks English minister were married in 1842. They settled in Grey County Ontario, three miles from Owen Sound, where they started the first school and Sunday school in that section in 1856 Mrs Brooks died at the age of 88 in 1903. Mr. Brooks at 52 on Aug 7 - 1865

Their daughter Mary Ann Brooks married Jeremiah Leslie from Donegal Ireland, he was a hotel man and farmer. He died at the age of 84 after retiring to Toronto Mrs. Leslie at the age of 79

Their oldest son married Mary Mand Leggate whom he met while in Duluth Minn. U.S.A. Their oldest daughter was born there Jan 1st 1860. They returned to Canada, to Owen Sound Ontario in 1901. Mr. Leslie was in the advertising business. Their oldest daughter married Harry Wm. Woffhard in Berlin Ontario in 1919. They have two children Leslie Mairil and William Henry

Geo Bond an English Shoemaker and Mary Dawson migrated to Canada after they were married. They settled in Brentwood Ont. They lived to be 88 and 84 ~~respectfully~~ respectively and were the parents of Mary Bond who married Jno Leggate, who moved to Black River Falls Wis. in 1866. They were pioneers in that section and had a farm of 160 acres on which their descendants still live (1955) Mrs Leggate died of a heart attack at the age of 69 and Mr. Leggate 82. He also died of a heart attack. Their oldest daughter Mary M. Leggate married John B. Leslie. They lived in Kitchener Ont.

Mr Leslie died at the age of 75 and Mrs Leslie at the age of 78 - in 1953.
