lawful money of Canada now paid by the said grantee to the said  
grantors (the receipt whereof is hereby by them acknowledged)  
they the said grantors DO GRANT unto the said grantee in fee simple  
each their undivided half interest in ALL and Singular that  
certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and  
being in the City of Kitchener, in the County of Waterloo and  
Province of Ontario, and being composed of parts of Lots Numbers  
One and Two according to plan made for Louis S. Weber and register-  
ed as Plan Number eighty-nine which said parts of Lots being more

COMMENCING at the northwesterly angle of Lot Number Four of said  
Survey where the same is intersected by the easterly limit of  
Queen Street with the northerly limit of Mill Street, THENCE

SUBJECT NEVERTHELESS to the reservations, limitations, provisoies and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown.

AND that the said grantee shall have quiet possession of the said lands free from all encumbrances.

AND the said grantor **s** COVENANT with the said grantee that **they will execute** such further assurances of the said lands as may be requisite.
