Transcript of Will.

This is the last will and testament of me Peter Holfhard of the Town of Berlin in the County of Waterloo and Province of Ontario Gentleman, made this fifteenth day November in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty.

I revoke all former Wills or other Testamentary Dispositions by me at any time heretofore made and declare this ^{only} to be and contain my last will and Testament.

I direct all my just debts, funeral and Testamentary expenses to be paid and satisfied by my Executor hereinafter named as soon as conveniently may be after my decease.

I give devise and bequeath all my real and Personal Estate of which I may die possessed in the manner following that is to say: To my beloved wife Margaretha the full and absolute use of my Estate both real and personal during her lifetime, and upon her death the entire estate shall be equally divided between my daughter Catherine Bertel and my sons Frederick Holfhard and Henry Holfhard, If my wife so desires the real estate can be sold by the Executor hereinafter mentioned at any time.

All the residue of my Estate not hereinbefore disposed of I give, devise and bequeath unto the hereinbefore mentioned parties, And I nominate and appoint my son Henry Holfhard to be executor of this my last will and testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand the day and year first above written.
