named in the Last Will and Testament of Christian Eley the Execut ors late of the
Town of Berlin aforesaid deceased, part of the
First part, and Peter Wolfhards of the Town of Berlin

Christian Eley of the third part

WHEREBY after reciting the said Will and the decease of the Testator, it is WITNESSED that in pursu-
ance of the powers vested in them by virtue of the said Will, and in consideration of One Hundred

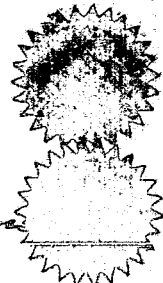
