A Memorial, to be Registered, of an Indenture, made the Twenty ninth day of March one thousand eight hundred and Sixty four in pursuance of the Act respecting short forms of Conveyances.

BETWEEN

John Rutter of the Village of Springville

in the County of Perth Carpenter of the FIRST PART,
Dorothea Wife of the said party of the First Part of the SECOND PART; and

Peter Wolfhard of the Town of Berlin in the County of Waterloo Labourer of the THIRD PART:

Whereby the said party of the First Part, in consideration of One Hundred and Ninety Five Dollars of lawful money of Canada, then paid by the said part of the Third Part to the said part of the First Part (the receipt whereof is thereby acknowledged), did grant unto the said part of the Third Part, his heirs and assigns, forever, All and singular those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises, situate, lying, and being in the

Town of Berlin in the County of Waterloo being composed of Part Lots Numbers Two and Three of David Weber Survey of Subdivision of Large Lot Number Four according to a Combined plan Made by Messrs Schofield and Hobson P.L.S. for the said David Weber, Abraham C. Weber and Christian Eley in 1859 and located and bounded as follows Commencing on the division line between Towns Six and Seven and Four and at the south east angle of Sub Lot Two then North $38^{\circ}30'$ West Eleven Chains thirty two links then South $64^{\circ}30'$ West Three Chains Sixty links then South $38^{\circ}30'$ East Eleven Chains Twenty nine and two links links then North $64^{\circ}30'$ East three Chains Sixty links to the place of beginning each Sub-Containing One acre and Ninety eight hundredths of an acre and containing within the whole Three acres and Ninety eight hundredths of an acre and to hold the said above premises unto the said part of the Third Part his heirs and assigns, to and for his and their sole and only use for ever: Subject to the reservations, limitations, provisoes and conditions in the original grant from the Crown.

And the said party of the Second Part thereby barred her DOWER in the said lands; Which said Indenture is witnessed by Ernst Schmidt of the Village of Springville, in said County, Township

And this Memorial thereof is hereby required to be registered by me, the said grantor therein named.
